**TOMAH, WI, May 6, 2026** — General Stamping & Metalworks (GSM) is proud to announce that its Tomah, Wisconsin manufacturing facility has been selected to receive a **Safety Award of Honor** from the **Fabricators and Manufacturers Association (FMA)**. This prestigious recognition honors metal fabrication companies that demonstrate an unwavering commitment to workplace safety.

The Safety Award of Honor is the highest level of recognition in the FMA's Annual Safety Awards program, presented to companies that achieved a **perfect safety record** with no recordable injuries or illnesses during the reporting period — January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. To be eligible, companies were required to submit OSHA Form 300A (Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses) and were evaluated against Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) injury and illness incidence rates within their NAICS code category. Companies of all sizes were eligible.
